

FaceTime Basics

Open and use FaceTime:

- Make sure your iPad is turned on.
- Look for the green button with the white video camera on the homepage.
- Tap the green video camera button.
- Look for the blue plus sign on the top right (+) and tap it

Make a call:

- Now you will need to enter either the iPhone number, or the Apple ID, for the person you are trying to call. The Apple ID is usually an email address. Once you enter the number/address, you can choose Audio (phone call) or the Video call.
- Tap the green button at the bottom and wait for the person to answer your call.

No answer? Leave a message:

If the person doesn't answer, you can choose the thought bubble to leave a text message.

What if someone calls you?

Slide the phone button from the right with your finger to answer.
