

Answering an iPad FaceTime Call

Before the FaceTime:

- You can get a FaceTime call on an iPhone or iPad.
- Make sure iPad is connected to your Wifi first.
- Before someone calls you, your screen may be locked, that is okay.
- Just make sure that your iPad is on.

Receiving A FaceTime Call:

- When your call comes in, you will see a darkened screen with a green phone button at the bottom.
- To answer, slide the button from left to right.

The Call Starts:

- When you have answered the call, you will see the person calling you, and your face will appear in a small box on the screen.

Ending FaceTime Call:

- When you want to hang up, tap the screen and you will see a red X on the screen. Tap the red X.
